**HPS 5513 is a course pending final approval, enrollment will be in HPA 5990 as a placeholder until the course is available in the scheduling system.

Credit hours: the fourth digit of the course number denotes the number of credit hours assigned to the course. A zero as the fourth digit indicates that the course is offered for a variable number of credit hours (i.e. 1 to 4 hours). Examples: BSE 502~~3~~.502 is a 3-credit hour course; CPH 794~~1~~.002 is a 1-credit hour course, etc.

Meet with faculty advisor. Before the start of every semester, you must meet with your assigned faculty advisor to discuss upcoming coursework. Once you and your advisor determine your schedule, complete and both sign the enrollment form, then email the form to hcophenroll@ouhsc.edu for processing.
