Additional health law-related courses are strongly recommended. • Successfully complete at least 60 hours at the College of Law • Successfully complete additional work sufficient to total 81 semester hours • Attain a cumulative grade point average of at least a 5.00 (C) in all work taken in the College of Law and a grade of C on all work taken at other approved law schools • Complete all degree requirements within five years of initial enrollment
